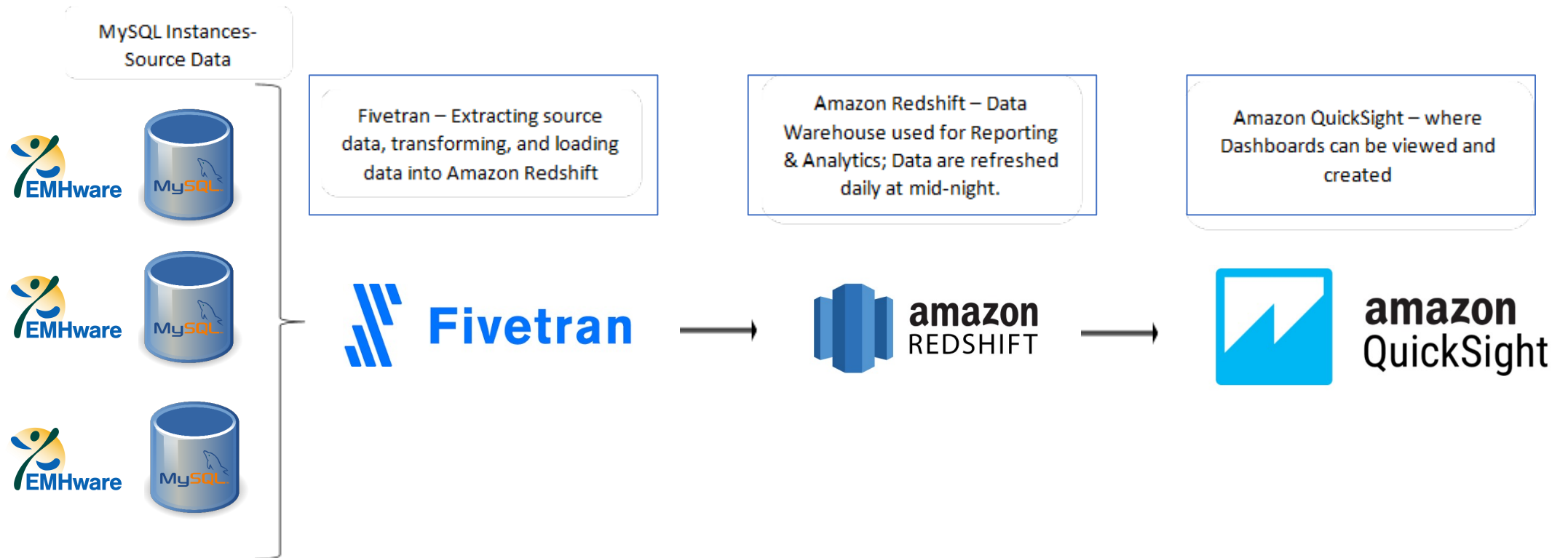
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What is the EMHware Analytics Module?

The EMHware Analytics Module is a dashboarding and reporting tool that will allow you to create data visualizations and custom reports to gain insight more easily than traditional generic reports. This module will put your data at the tip of your fingers in a digestible way.

Privacy

Quicksight allows for row-level privacy. This means we can ensure that people only have access to the individual records they should be able to see.

This level of privacy, will impactful as we get to Phase 3 of the BI Module roll out (self-service), due to the information being displayed in the dashboards. We will be displaying Client ID numbers rather than client names. If you would like further information you can go into the client record in EMHware, using the EMHware client search.

Sample Table Documentation

emh_client

This is a client table that houses most of the information about clients. The data ranges from names, birthdays, addresses, phone numbers, SIN numbers, OHIP numbers etc. When the term “client dataset” is used, this refers to anything pertaining to clients. This speaks to addresses, locations, demographic information and specific client level information. Much of this information can also be aggregated. Not all of this information is present in the emh_client table (parent table), but is rather spread out across other child tables that it maps to such as the emh_client_address or emh_client_gender or emh_client_events etc. tables.

Some commonly used data elements from the emh_client parent table:

Column Name	Data Definition
client_id	This is the backend client id that is mapped across other tables. This client id is always referred to when doing joins with other tables. It is also on auto increment and a new client id will be generated automatically for new clients.
id	This is the front-end client ID that users see when they use EMHware
location	The city that a client is in
gender_cd	The gender they identify with
aboriginal_status	Aboriginal status noted in the client dataset
